Scope of Work

- Dust all horizontal surfaces including furniture, window sills, and ledges.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces such as door handles, light switches, and bed rails.
- Vacuum carpeted areas and mop hard floors using a colour-coded system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Empty rubbish bins and replace liners, ensuring waste is disposed of according to facility protocols.
- Clean and sanitise the ensuite toilet and bathroom facilities, including taps, basins, and shower areas.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with infection control standards as per Australian Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Infection in Healthcare.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with appropriate colour-coded cloths and mops.
- 2. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfibre cloth to capture dust and allergens.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch areas with a hospital-grade disinfectant, ensuring contact time as per product instructions.
- 4. Vacuum carpets using a HEPA-filtered vacuum cleaner to minimise airborne particles.
- 5. Mop hard floors with a neutral detergent, followed by a disinfectant solution.
- 6. Clean the ensuite bathroom, starting with the least contaminated areas (e.g., taps) and finishing with the toilet.
- 7. Dispose of waste in accordance with facility waste management protocols.

- · HEPA-filtered vacuum cleaner

- Hospital-grade disinfectant
- · Colour-coded mops and buckets

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean and free from dust, stains, and marks. No odours present. High-touch areas are sanitised with no residue. Floors are spotless and dry. Waste bins are empty and clean.
Good	Surfaces are mostly clean with minimal dust or marks. No strong odours. High-touch areas are sanitised with minimal residue. Floors are clean with slight dampness. Waste bins are emptied but may have minor residue.
Pass	Surfaces have some dust or marks. Mild odours may be present. High-touch areas are sanitised but with visible residue. Floors are clean but damp. Waste bins are emptied but not cleaned.
Fail	Surfaces are visibly dusty or stained. Strong odours present. High-touch areas are not sanitised. Floors are dirty or wet. Waste bins are full or dirty.
