## Australian National Cleaning Management Framework (ANCMF)

# **Water Feature**

Code: ANCMF-AU-GB-WF-01 • Facility: Government Building • Frequency: daily

### **Scope of Work**

- Remove debris and rubbish from the water feature.
- Clean and sanitise surrounding surfaces and edges.
- Wipe down any accessible decorative elements.
- Ensure water clarity by removing visible contaminants.
- Dust and wipe surrounding areas to prevent dirt accumulation.

#### Method

- 1. Use a net to remove floating debris and rubbish from the water surface.
- 2. Apply a suitable cleaning solution to a cloth and wipe down the edges and surfaces surrounding the water feature.
- 3. Use a soft cloth to gently clean decorative elements, ensuring no damage occurs.
- 4. Inspect the water for clarity and remove any visible contaminants using appropriate tools.
- 5. Dust and wipe surrounding areas with a microfibre cloth to prevent dirt accumulation.

## **Equipment**

- Net for debris removal
- Microfibre cloths

- Cleaning solution suitable for water features
- Rubbish bin for debris disposal
- Soft cloth for delicate surfaces

### **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	Water is crystal clear with no visible debris; all surfaces are spotless and dry; no odours present; decorative elements are pristine.
Good	Water is clear with minimal debris; surfaces are clean with slight moisture; no unpleasant odours; decorative elements are clean.
Pass	Water has some cloudiness; surfaces have minor smudges; faint odours may be present; decorative elements have minor dust.
Fail	Water is murky with visible debris; surfaces are dirty or wet; strong odours present; decorative elements are dusty or dirty.
