# **Walking Path**

Code: ANCMF-AU-GB-WP-01 • Facility: Government Building • Frequency: daily

## **Scope of Work**

- Remove all rubbish and debris from walking paths.
- Dust and wipe down all surfaces, including railings and benches.
- Vacuum or sweep paths to remove dirt and dust.
- Mop hard surfaces with appropriate cleaning solution.
- Sanitise high-touch areas such as railings and door handles.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with colour-coded cleaning systems.

#### Method

- 1. Inspect the walking path for any rubbish or debris and remove it using a trolley and rubbish bin.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a microfibre cloth, ensuring no dust remains visible.
- 3. Vacuum carpeted areas using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner to minimise airborne dust.
- 4. Mop hard surfaces with a neutral pH cleaner, ensuring no streaks or residue remain.
- 5. Sanitise high-touch areas with a hospital-grade disinfectant, following the manufacturer's instructions for contact time.
- 6. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all areas meet the quality criteria.

## **Equipment**

• Microfibre cloths

- Mop and bucket with neutral pH cleaner
- Trolley and rubbish bin

- HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner
- Hospital-grade disinfectant

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are spotless with no visible dust or debris. High-touch areas are sanitised and free of any marks. Floors are streak-free and dry. No odours present.
Good	Minor dust or debris may be present in low-traffic areas. High-touch areas are sanitised but may have minor marks. Floors are mostly streak-free and dry. No strong odours present.
Pass	Noticeable dust or debris in some areas. High-touch areas are sanitised but have visible marks. Floors may have streaks or be slightly damp. Mild odours may be present.
Fail	Significant dust or debris present. High-touch areas are not sanitised and have visible marks. Floors are streaked or wet. Strong odours present.
