Scope of Work

- Remove all visible debris and scrap metal remnants from the floor.
- Dust all surfaces, including machinery and storage areas, using appropriate dust control methods.
- Mop floors with industrial-grade cleaning solutions to remove any grease or oil residues.
- Sanitise high-touch surfaces such as door handles and control panels.
- Empty and clean rubbish bins, ensuring proper waste segregation.
- Inspect and clean drains to prevent blockages and odours.

Method

- 1. Conduct a preliminary inspection to identify areas requiring immediate attention.
- 2. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 3. Employ industrial vacuums to remove dust and small debris from surfaces and floors.
- 4. Apply degreasing agents to oily surfaces, followed by thorough mopping.

- 6. Dispose of waste in accordance with local regulations, ensuring recycling protocols are followed.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible debris or dust; surfaces are spotless and sanitised; no odours present; waste bins are empty and clean; drains are clear and odour-free.
Good	Minor dust or debris in less accessible areas; surfaces are clean with minimal streaks; faint odours may be present; waste bins are emptied but may have minor residue.
Pass	Noticeable dust or debris in some areas; surfaces are generally clean but may have visible marks; odours are noticeable; waste bins are emptied but not cleaned.
Fail	Significant dust or debris accumulation; surfaces are visibly dirty; strong odours present; waste bins are full or overflowing; drains are blocked or emitting odours.
